

“Namib - Horizon” 12 Days guided tour 2010

1. Day: Windhoek – Sossusvlei Lodge

Your tour guide will pick you up at your hotel at 09h00. You depart from the capital and travel via the Khomas Hochland Mountains down the magnificent Sreetshoogte Pass into the Namib valley. A picnic lunch is enjoyed enroute. Arrive at Le Mirage in the afternoon. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Sossusvlei Lodge. (approx. 300 kilometres)

2. Day: Sossusvlei Lodge – Rostock Desert Lodge

Today we visit Sossusvlei. Many visitors to Namibia say that no part of the desert is visually more stunning than Sossusvlei with its monumentally high dunes, the shadows of their sinuous crests continually changing as the day waxes and wanes. These gigantic star-shaped mountains of sand are a sought-after topic for artists and photographers. The warm tint of the sand, ranging from pale apricot to brick orange and deep red, contrast vividly with the dazzling white surfaces of the large deflationary clay pans at the bases of some of them. Lunch at Sossusvlei Lodge. Afterwards continue to Rostock Desert Lodge near Ghaub Canyon. Enjoy the vistas from the swimmingpool. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Rostock Desert Lodge. (approx. 290 kilometres)

3. Day: Rostock - Swakopmund

Drive via Ghaub and Kuiseb Canyon and through the Welwitschia plains with many examples of this well-known desert plant, which best represents Namibia. With some luck you can see ostriches, springbok or oryx antelopes, another species which is extremely well adapted to the desert environment. Enjoy lunchpacks enroute. You stop at the eerie, outer-worldly moonvalley and arrive in Swakopmund in the late afternoon. After a refreshing shower, you can enjoy a sumptuous three-course dinner at the Hansa Hotel. Dinner Bed and Breakfast at the 4-star Hansa Hotel. (approx. 250 kilometres)

4. Day: Swakopmund

Today we participate on a dolphin & seal cruise in the lagoon of Walvis Bay. Sparkling wine and snacks are served (light lunch). Return to Swakopmund and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner on own account. Your guide can assist you on planning this afternoon. Attractions are: scenic flights, angling expeditions, camel rides and much more. All these excursions are on own account. You can enjoy your coffee in a café, go swim at the mole or visit the museum or aquarium. Overnight on a bed and breakfast basis at the Hansa Hotel. (approx. 70 kilometres)

5. Day: Swakopmund – Erongo Wilderness Lodge

Our journey takes us land inward past the Rössing Mountain to the Spitzkoppe, a fascinating granite boulder range. Enjoy lunchpacks at the Rock Arch. Continue along the northern side of the Erongo Mountains to Erongo Wilderness Lodge.. For sundowners it is worthwhile climbing the nearby hill with an awesome view. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Erongo Wilderness Lodge. (approx. 300 kilometres)

6. Day: Erongo Wilderness Lodge – Doro !Nawas

Drive via Uis, past the Brandberg Mountain into Damaraland. We enjoy Lunchpacks enroute. Visit engravings at Twyfelfontein, visit the Burnt Mountain and the Organ Pipes in the afternoon. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Doro !Nawas. Tonight you can push your bed onto the terrace (weather permitting) and sleep under the crystal clear starry night sky. (approx. 300 kilometres)

7. Day: Doro !Nawas – Grootberg Lodge

On this morning we take part on a nature drive along the dry Aba Huab River in search for the desert dwelling elephant. After lunch continue to Grootberg Lodge. and visit the petrified forest enroute. We enjoy lunchpacks enroute. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Grootberg Lodge. (approx. 120 kilometres)

8. Day: Grootberg Lodge - Huab Lodge

Today's drive takes us over the Grootberg Pass to Huab Lodge. Nature drives and guided walks will make your stay at the lodge a memorable one. Overnight on a fullboard basis including activities at Huab Lodge.

9. Day: Huab – Okaukuejo Resort

After the morning activity today's journey takes us to the famous Etosha National Park. After lunch you will to the first game drive. Overnight on a bed and breakfast basis at Okaukuejo Resort. (approx. 270 kilometres)

10. Day: Okaukuejo - Mushara

Gamedrive throughout the day through Etosha National Park until you reach Mushara Lodge, at the eastern entrance of the park before sunset. In the park you can view elephant, cheetahs, leopards, rhinos, zebra, giraffes and many more mammals as well as up to 340 different bird species. Lunch on own account. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Mushara Lodge. (approx.250 kilometres)

11. Day: Etosha Nationalpark

Enjoy a further gamedrive in Etosha Nationalpark. You drive from waterhole to waterhole searching for elephant, predators and antilopes. Lunch on own account. Overnight on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis at Mushara Lodge. (approx. 200 kilometres)

12. Day: Mushara – Windhoek

Drive via Tsumeb, Otavi, Otjiwarongo and Okahandja to Windhoek. Lunch enroute. Your journey ends at your hotel in Windhoek. (approx. 530 kilometres)
